Currently, 76.7% of the 23,040 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 17.5%, renter occupied; and 5.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 22,078 housing units in the area - 78.7% owner occupied, 15.0% renter occupied, and 6.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.91%. Median home value in the area is \$254,246, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.99% annually to \$280,544.
