Currently, 44.5% of the 124,708 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 46.1%, renter occupied; and 9.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 122,677 housing units in the area - 48.7% owner occupied, 42.5% renter occupied, and 8.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.73%. Median home value in the area is \$184,038, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.25% annually to \$215,995.
